NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The prescriptions of the National Authority will not apply.
- 1.3. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the 22er Binnenjolle class.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form on-line (www.byc.hu) or sending it before 23:59 GMT+1 15. August 2010 to byc@byc.hu, or
Balatonfüredi Yacht Club, Zákonyi Ferenc sétány 2., Balatonfüred, 8230, Hungary.
- 3.3. Late entries will be accepted on paying an additional 30 EUR per boat.

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fee is 150 EUR for each boat that is required to be paid by bank transfer before 23:59 GMT+1 15. August 2010.
- 4.2. The entry fee includes the official memorabilia for each competitor and the social events during the regatta.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Registration and entry:
Time and date: 14:00-18:00 hrs, 23. August 2010.
Place: Regatta Office, Balatonfüredi Yacht Club Clubhouse 1st floor
- 5.2. Measurement and inspection:
Measurement and inspection will take place during the registration period in the port.
- 5.3. Opening ceremony and competitors' briefing:
Opening ceremony and competitors' briefing will be held at the event hangar at 09:00 24. August 2010.
- 5.4. Dates of racing:
24. August 2010. races back to back
25. August 2010. races back to back
26. August 2010. long distance race
- 5.5. Number of races:
There are seven races scheduled with no more than three sailed on a day.
- 5.6. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10:55 hrs, 24. August 2010.
- 5.7. Any race on 26. August 2010. for which a warning signal is not given by 15:00 hrs will be abandoned and not re-sailed.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Copies of Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Office during registration.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The regatta will be at Balatonfüredi Yacht Club.
- 7.2. The racing area will be among Balatonfüred-Siófok-Zamárdi-Tihany.

8. THE COURSE

An up-and-down course will be sailed except for the long distance race.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM, INTERNATIONAL JURY

9.1. Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9.2. An international jury will be appointed in accordance with rule Appendix N and perform the duties listed in RRS N2.

9.3. Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in Rule 70.5.

10. SCORING

10.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

10.2. 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3. (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 4 or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the port.

12. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

13. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15. PRIZES

15.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats.

15.2. Other special prizes will be awarded.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 500.000 EUR per event or the equivalent.

18. MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
